This Week's Missionary Tidbits: Bibles International

Gary Walton, head of Stewardship and Church Relations, writes to inform supporting churches of the difficulties faced by those called to translate the Word of God in to the language of the people; something we take for granted. Prayer requests for BI in India are:

- 1.) The people of the village of Kabuikhullen need to move 4 kilometers due to the damage caused by the January earthquake. Their water supply has fallen between the cracks and will never return.
- 2.) Christian nationals were stopped by some men demanding money for one of the gods. They said they could not give because they were Christians. They were severely beaten. An outcry from the people coupled with a strike prompted the government officials to arrest the men, but these men were sons of local government officers and so were not arrested. The strike continues. See the King's Daughters' bulletin board for additional prayer concerns.
